After downloading, open the file and **read pages 2 & 3 immediately** before proceeding. The Table of Contents on page 4 is clickable and will take you to each section by clicking the title. You can read or print from your saved file at anytime.

Recent browser updates have been causing the files to be saved with an arbitrary ".rtf" file extension. The files are PDF, not .rtf. If the file will not open after download, you can rename the file on PC or MAC by locating the file, or on Android using your file explorer. iPhone/iPad will not let you rename the file – download to a computer or storage.

Software/Apps needed:

To view the PDF Study Guide: Download & install Acrobat Reader or an equivalent PDF Reader program/app if one is not already installed.

Windows – Desktop/Laptop

PDF Study Guide Download:

1. Click the download link at the top of this page ONCE and select "Save" or "Save Target As" when prompted. SAVE THE FILE.
2. Follow prompts to save the file to your location, remember where you saved the PDF file – wait for the download to complete.
3. Go to your folder where your PDF file is saved and click on your saved file. If it does not open correctly, you must open the Adobe Reader program first.

Macintosh Desktop/Laptop

PDF Study Guide Download:

1. Switch to CHROME OR FIREFOX BROWSER: Either control+click or click and hold the mouse button down on the link until the menu pops up.
2. Select "SAVE" or "download" , and save the file to the disk. Select the file type before you click OK (the file type is PDF).
3. Wait for the download to complete.
4. Go to your folder where your PDF file is saved and click on your saved file. If it does not open correctly, you must open the Adobe Reader program first.

IPhone / iPad

PDF Study Guide Download:

1. USING CHROME OR FIREFOX BROWSER: Click the link ONCE, select OPEN IN IBOOKS, and WAIT for the file to download. The iPhone/iPad doesn't give you any notification that the download has started, or any sort of download progress bar- you will know the download is complete when you see the pop-up screen.
2. If the download stalls or does not complete on the first try, download to a real computer and transfer your file to your phone or tablet using iBooks or iTunes or a USB cable.
3. Adobe Reader will give you more functionality and options. GoodNotes will allow you to take notes on your screen.

Android Phones & Tablets including Kindle:

PDF Study Guide Download:

1. Click the link ONCE and wait – a small popup will appear that says 'starting download'. Wait for the download complete arrow appears on the notifications bar.
2. Go to 'My Files' folder and click 'all files', 'device storage', 'downloads'.
3. Click the .PDF file you want to read and choose your PDF reader from the list. Adobe Reader will give you more functionality and options.

DOWNLOAD INSTRUCTIONS for AUDIO REVIEW:

Software/Apps needed:

To extract AUDIO REVIEW files - MOBILE DEVICES ONLY:

Download & Install WinZip or IZip app (free version) for MOBILE DEVICES ONLY.

Windows & MAC have extraction software as part of the operating system.

Windows – Desktop/Laptop

Audio Review File Download:

1. Click the download link and select "Save" or "Save Target As" when prompted. Follow prompts to save the file to your location, remember where you saved the .zip file. .
2. Locate the file you saved and right-click it.
3. From the menu, select Extract to/(name of file).
4. This will create a new sub-folder with all the MP3 files inside, named the same as your download .zip file. You should now have a 'zip file' and a 'folder'.
5. Double-click the newly created folder to view its contents. Click on an MP3 to listen to the file – your media player should start automatically.
6. You can listen to the Audio Review from your saved folder at anytime.

Macintosh Desktop/Laptop

Audio Review File Download:

1. Either control+click or click and hold the mouse button down on the link until the menu pops up. Select "save" or "download" the file to the disk.
2. Select the file type before you click OK (the file type should be ZIP or source, depending on your browser).
3. Go to your folder where your Audio Review .zip file is saved and double click on your saved file. The files will be extracted to the same folder as the zip file.
4. You can listen to the Audio Review files from your saved folder at anytime.

IPhone / iPad

Audio Review Files Download:

The easiest way to get your files onto your iPhone or iPad is to download to a

computer and transfer or sync to iTunes.

File Transfer:

1. Files can be copied back and forth between a desktop or laptop computer and apps on an Apple mobile device via a USB connection or Wi-Fi local network.
2. This can be done through the iTunes program installed on the desktop or laptop and synced with the Apple mobile device.
3. When using iTunes, the device (iPad, iPhone or iPod) is selected under Library in the upper right corner of the iTunes screen on the desktop or laptop computer.
4. The USB connection is default. Wi-Fi will only work after enabled in iTunes.
5. Once the device comes up, click on "Apps" on the top menu.
6. At the bottom of the Apps page, the file transfer function can be found, which can be used to send folders or files in either direction.

Direct download:

- Safari will not open a .zip file, change your browser to FireFox or Chrome.
 - Apple won't let iPhones or iPads download files larger than 100 megabytes unless they are connected to WiFi. The audio zip files are VERY LARGE, most over 100MB.
1. Click the link ONE TIME and WAIT. The iPhone/iPad doesn't give you any notification that the download has started, or any sort of download progress bar- you will know the download is complete when you see the pop-up screen.
 2. If the file does not download you will have to download to a computer as above.
 3. Locate your downloaded file
 4. Click on "Open in..." and choose WinZip".
 5. The WinZip screen will open.
 6. Click on the word "WinZip". You will see a list of folders.
 7. Click on the "My Files" folder.
 8. You will see the downloaded zip file listed inside My Files folder. Click on it.
 9. The file should start unzipping. Unzipping large zip files takes time. WinZip displays an "Unzipping..." progress bar.
 10. After WinZip opens the zip file, you should be able to click on any MP3 to listen.

Android Phones & Tablets including Kindle:

Audio Review File Download:

1. Click the link ONCE and wait – a small popup will appear that says 'starting download'. Wait for the download complete arrow appears on the notifications bar.
2. Go to 'My Files' folder and click 'all files', 'device storage', 'downloads'.
3. Click the .ZIP file.
4. Click on the MP3 file you want to listen to.
5. Be sure your volume is turned up sufficiently to hear the file.
